



Peter Horn was born to Lawrence and Esther Horn on April 30, 1946 in Sturgis, SD. Peter was raised and educated on the Cheyenne River Indian Reservation in South Dakota. Pete graduated from Eagle Butte High School in 1965, then joined the Army and served two tours in Vietnam.

Peter's employment and lifestyle, since 1979 to present, revolved around his work in the chemical dependency field. He worked for the Indian Health Service in Eagle Butte as the Assistant House Manager at a halfway house from 1979 to 1983. From 1983 to 1985, he was a Detention Officer for the Cheyenne River Tribal Police. While in that position, he completed training with the state of South Dakota and was certified as a South Dakota Law Officer. From 1985 to 1988, he worked for the Indian Health Service at Sioux San Hospital in Rapid City in their Drug and Alcohol Treatment Program. It is here that he completed training and was certified as a Chemical Dependency Counselor, Level I. From 1988 to 1991, he was the Coordinator and Counselor at the Cheyenne River Tribal Alcoholism Program in Eagle Butte. He returned to Rapid City Sioux San Hospital from 1991 to 1992 and worked as a CD Counselor for the Transitional Care Program. Peter was currently working at the CRST Alcohol and Drug Program in Eagle Butte.

Survivors include his wife, Virginia Horn; daughter, Rosemary Horn; son, Nathan Horn; and granddaughter, Lindsey Richards.

Peter is preceded in death by his parents, Lawrence and Esther Horn; brother, John Horn; and two sisters, Viola Keelick and Betty Earing.
