Gayle Holy, 50, of San Carlos Apache Reservation, AZ and formerly of Bridger, SD, passed away Wednesday, June 29, 2016 at Campbell County Memorial Hospital, Gillette, WY.

Gayle Louis Holy was born December 25, 1965, in Bridger, SD to Martin J. Holy and Leona Agnes Bear Eagle. He attended school in Philip and Bridger, SD. He later went on to receive his G.E.D.
