Roletta Pretty Weasel, 62, of Eagle Butte passed away Wednesday, July 20, 2016 at Rapid City Regional Hospital.

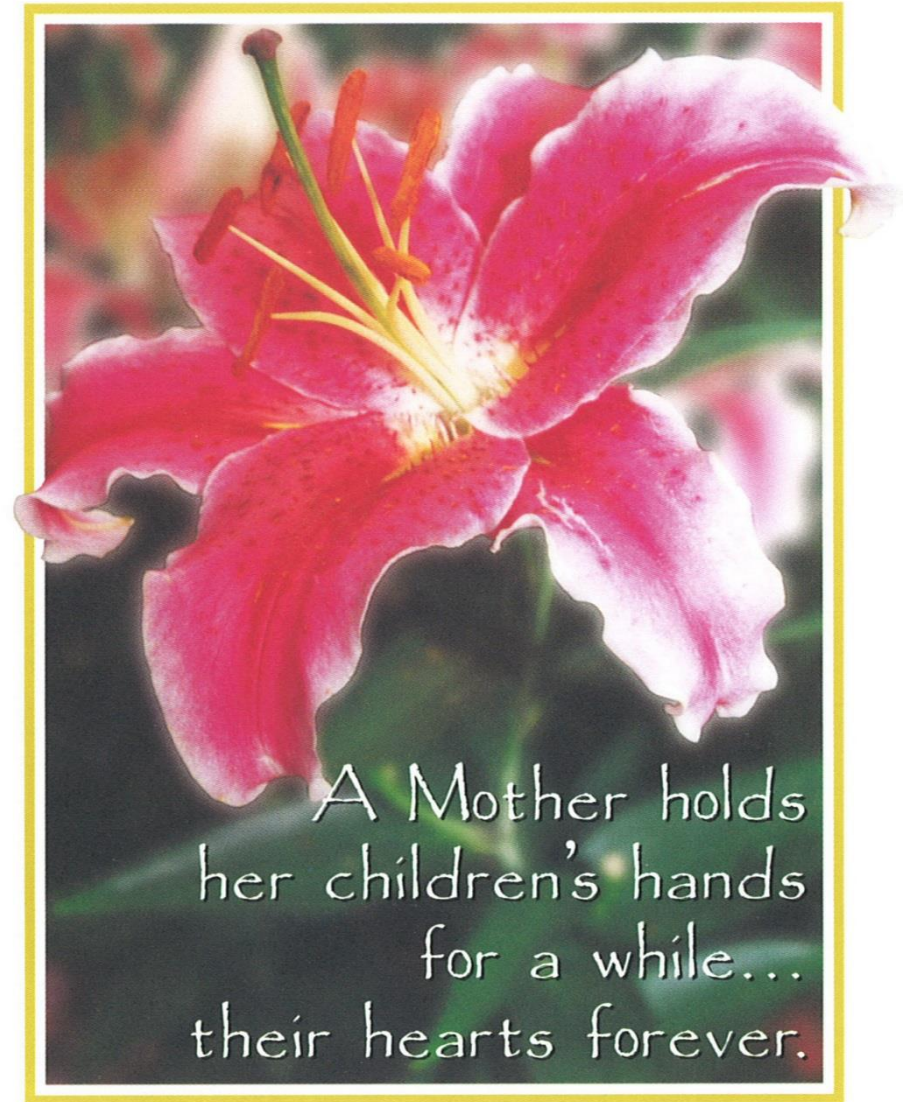
