Frank Charles Veit, 61, of Dupree, passed away Sunday, March 5, 2017, at his home after battling many health issues.

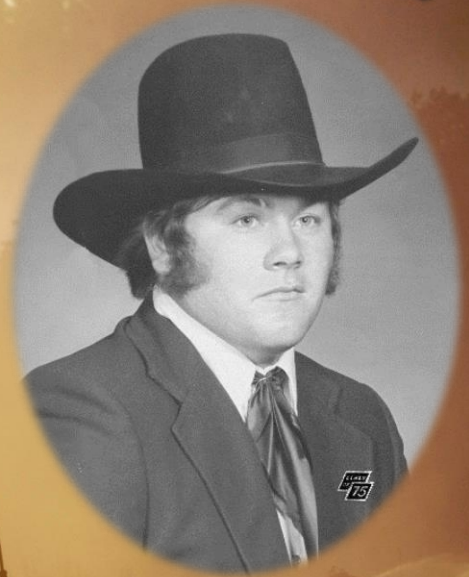
