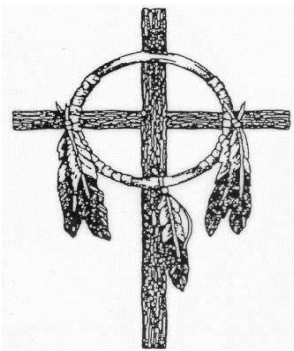

Rebecca “Becky” Nancy Condon was born July 17, 1951 to Felix and Mary (Little Wounded) Condon at the Old Cheyenne Agency. She was the youngest of 16 children. Becky spent most of her childhood in Cherry Creek with her mother, Mary. They would go out in the country to visit Mr. and Mrs. Olney Runs After’s home. On May 30, 2017, Becky became ill and was placed in the hospital in Provo, Utah; where she was surrounded by her loved ones as she made her journey to the spirit world.
