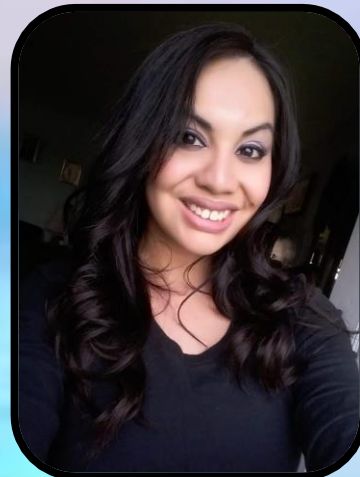


Ronni had one son whom she adored dearly, Grant Vernon Martin III, born on August 8, 2014.

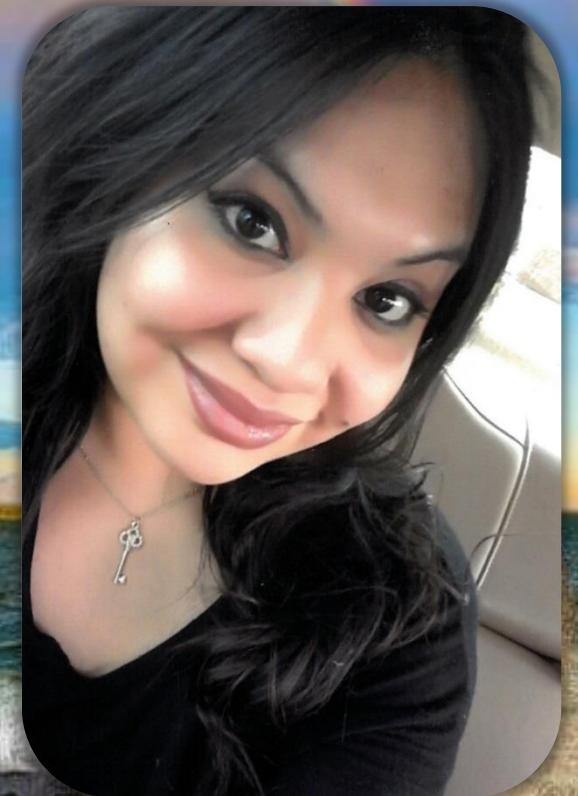
