You're shaking your head as you read this...

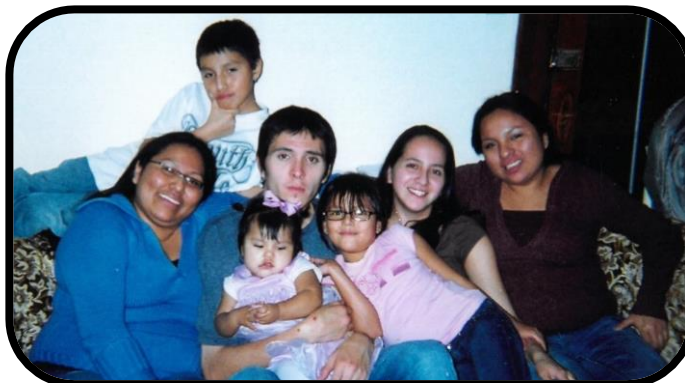
I've created it just for you.
