Gary Lee Marrowbone Jr. was born September 19, 1966 to Gary Sr., and Linda Yellow Owl Marrowbone. He attended elementary school at Cherry Creek Day School and Red Scaffold Day School. He graduated from Crow Creek High School on May 30, 1964.

On May 17, 1988, Sgt. Gary Marrowbone Jr. enlisted into the United State Army. He did his basic training at Fort Ord, CA with the 13th Engineer Battalion. He was a Combat Engineer and served in Operation Just Cause Panama (1989) and Operation Desert Storm (1990). Gary was discharge from the Army in 1992, after serving four years.
