In January 1996, she worked as Home Base Educator for the (F.A.C.E) Family and Child Education for seven years and in 2003 she was selected from the National Center for Parents as Teachers program to become a FACE Technical Assistance Consultant for the Baby Face Program. She worked with six sites across North and South Dakota. She also worked for the Aberdeen Area Tribal Chairmen's Health Board as a site coordinator for four years.
