Tristan was one of the first Takini Runners in 2012 for the Wounded Knee Survivors Run, along with his older brother Wyatt Belt. Tristan loved to work out, lift weights, he learned to box when he was younger. He was tough and relentless when he competed.

His siblings will miss him deeply and we will all miss his smile.
