Delbert Chasing Hawk, 75, of Ft. Yates, ND, passed away Thursday, June 26, 2025, at Ft. Yates IHS Hospital, Ft Yates, ND.

Delbert Neil Chasing Hawk was born December 2, 1949, in Little Eagle, SD to Leo and Lizzie (Tree Top) Chasing Hawk. At a very young age, he and his brothers were involved in dancing and riding horses. Del and his brother Everette did a lot of shows for tourists at Fort Lincoln during the summers. He did a blanket dance act that went very well with the crowd. He also took part in the Custer Drama Show, being Sitting Bull's son. Delbert owned his first horse at eight years old and grew up on a horse. Later, he would travel with the Rodeo Far West show in Italy, France and Switzerland. Delbert also participated in rodeos as a young man.

Being a good athlete, he led the Little Eagle Golden Eagles to an undefeated season in his eighth-grade year. He later took his talents to Fort Yates, where he and his teammates, Dean Little Dog, Jim Gross, Bob Eagle Staff and his brother Everett, took the Warriors to the 1969 North Dakota State Basketball Tournament.

Delbert was a Head Start teacher for fourteen years, and he worked at the Prairie Knights Casino for four years.
