Eunice P. Holmstrom, 94, of Faulkton, passed away, Wednesday, December 21, 2011 at her daughter's home in Boise, Idaho.

Eunice P. Stebbins was born November 23, 1917, to Emery and Emma (Schuett) Stebbins in Gettysburg, SD. She was raised north of Gettysburg until moving to the Lebanon area where she started school.
