Lloyd Payne, 92, of Orient, passed away, Wednesday, January 2, 2013, at the Faulkton Healthcare Center.

Lloyd Edwin Payne was born June 23, 1920 in Faulk County, SD to Clinton and Katharine (Waldner) Payne. He attended grade school at Onaka and graduated from Faulkton High School in 1939.

In August 1944 he enlisted in the United States Army. He was stationed at Camp Crowder, MO and spent time briefly in the Hawaiian and Philippine Island and also did a short tour in Japan. Lloyd was honorably discharged in August 1946.


In 1950 he received a Bachelor of Science degree in civil engineering from SDSU at Brookings. He went to work for the Boeing Company in Wichita, KS from 1952 to 1968.
