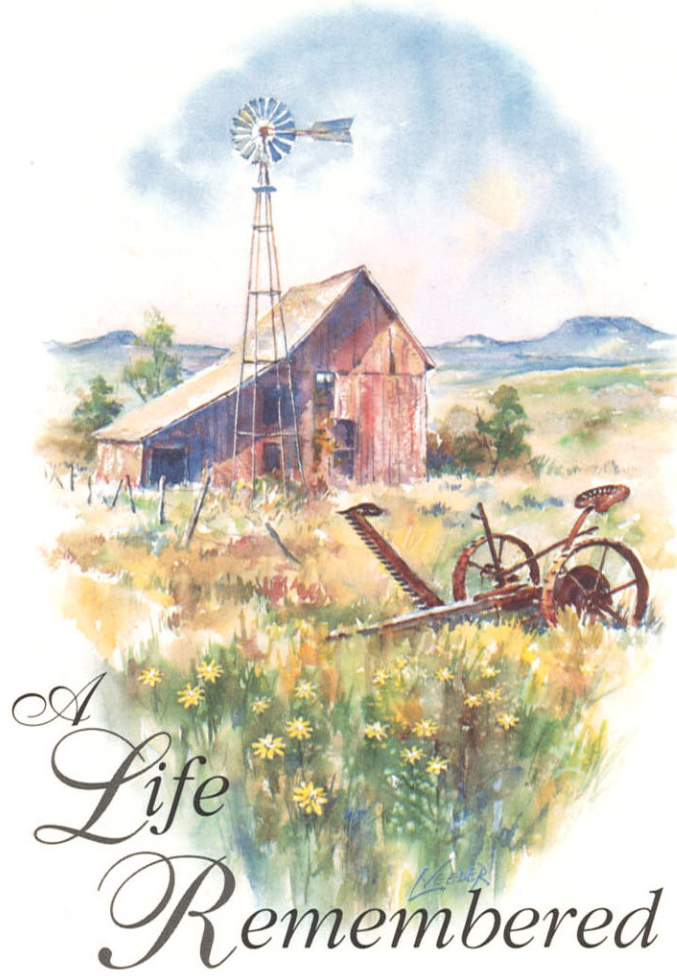
In 1966 Harold joined the South Dakota National Guard, serving for six years.
