And if you listen with your

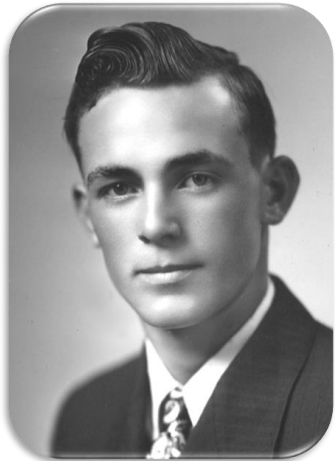
heart you will hear
