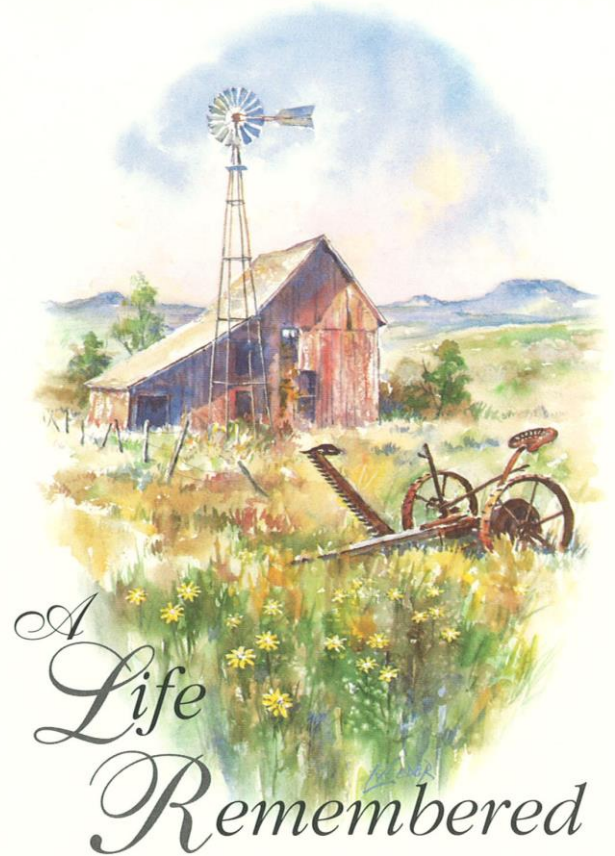
Bob married Rita Lynch on June 11, 1988 in Iroquois, SD.
