Carol Ann "Dolly" Geist, 71, of Faulkton, passed away on Tuesday, March 31, 2015, at the Faulkton Area Medical Center.

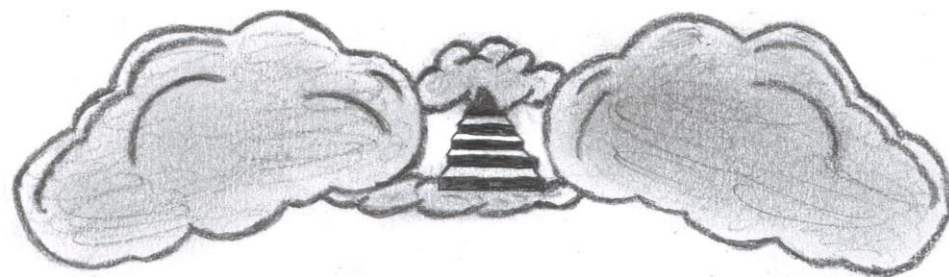
