But, God had other plans.

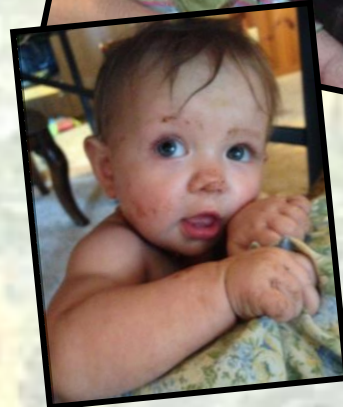
I was your perfect angel,

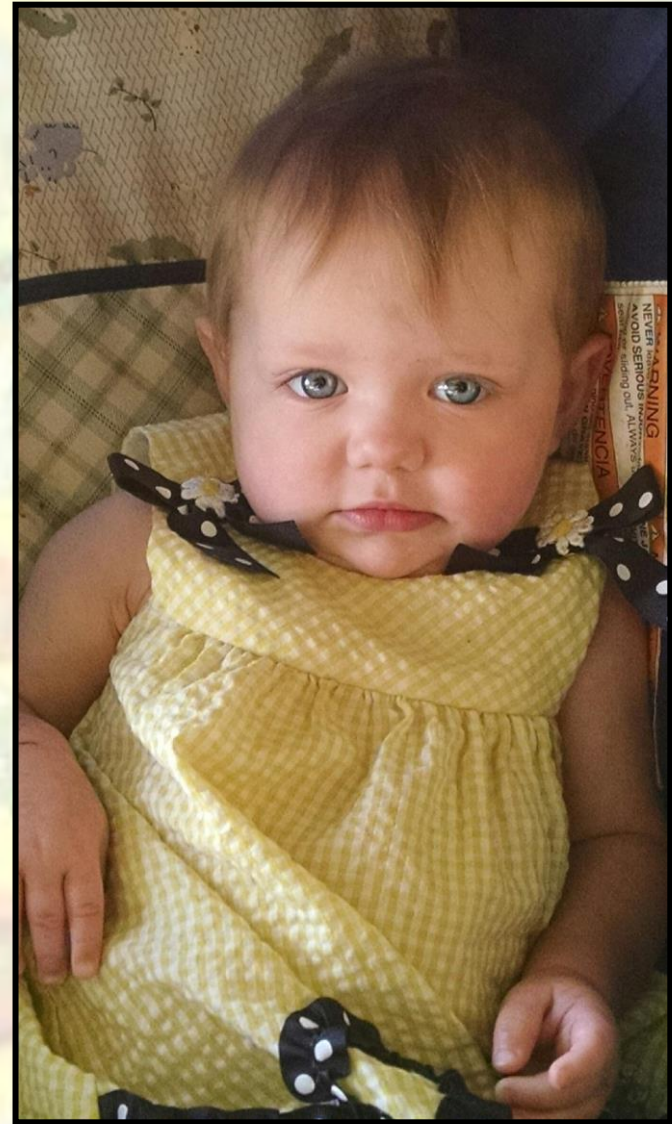
