that God was coming to call your name.

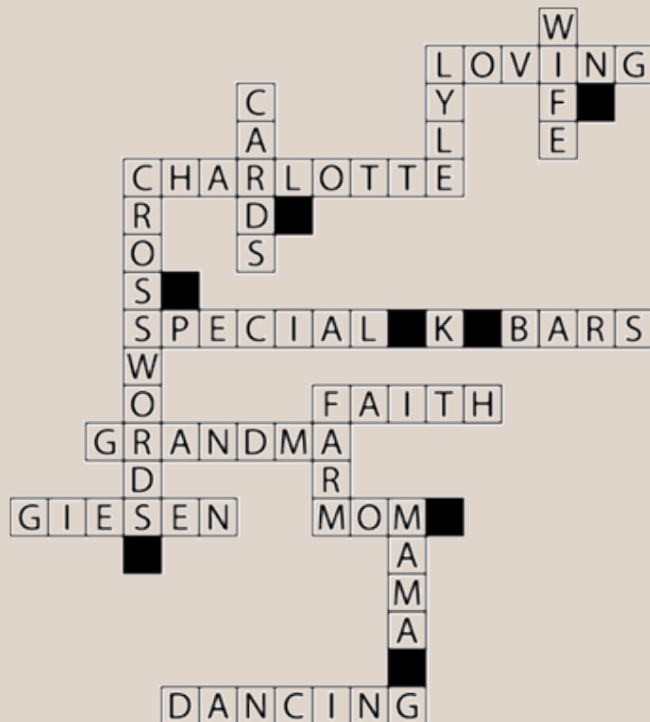
In life we loved you dearly,
