**Donald V. Joachim**, 81, of the South Dakota Veteran's Home of Hot Springs and formerly of Agar, passed away Friday, August 9, 2013 at the VA Black Hills Health Care System, Hot Springs.

Donald was born June 28, 1932 at a farmhouse southwest of Agar, SD to Alvin and Lillian (Kulhavy) Joachim. He spent his entire life in Agar and graduated from Agar High School in 1950. From 1951-1953 he was in the United States army, serving during the Korean War.

On April 17, 1955 he was united in marriage to Kathleen Johnson at Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Gettysburg. They made their home in Pierre for a short time, where Donald worked for the Reminder. Later they moved to Sully County and returned to the farm.
