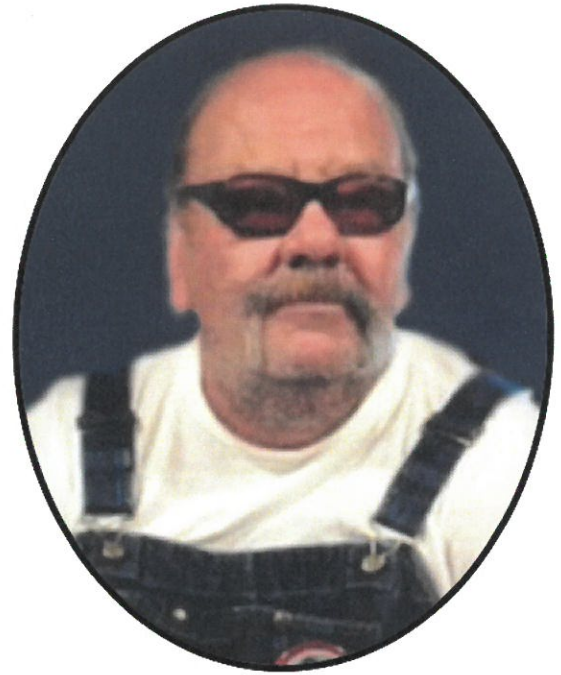
*Buck enjoyed the open highway, whether traveling by truck or motorcycle. He crisscrossed the country as a trucker. He also worked for several area farmers.*

***The Road Travelled***

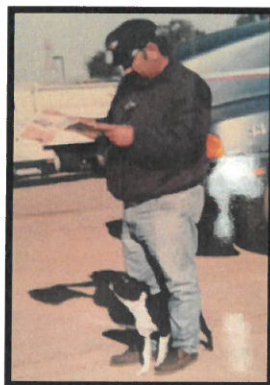
As a biker, we are unique
