Dennis Roy Lenz, 71, of Gettysburg, passed away peacefully on Monday, September 2, 2019 at his home.

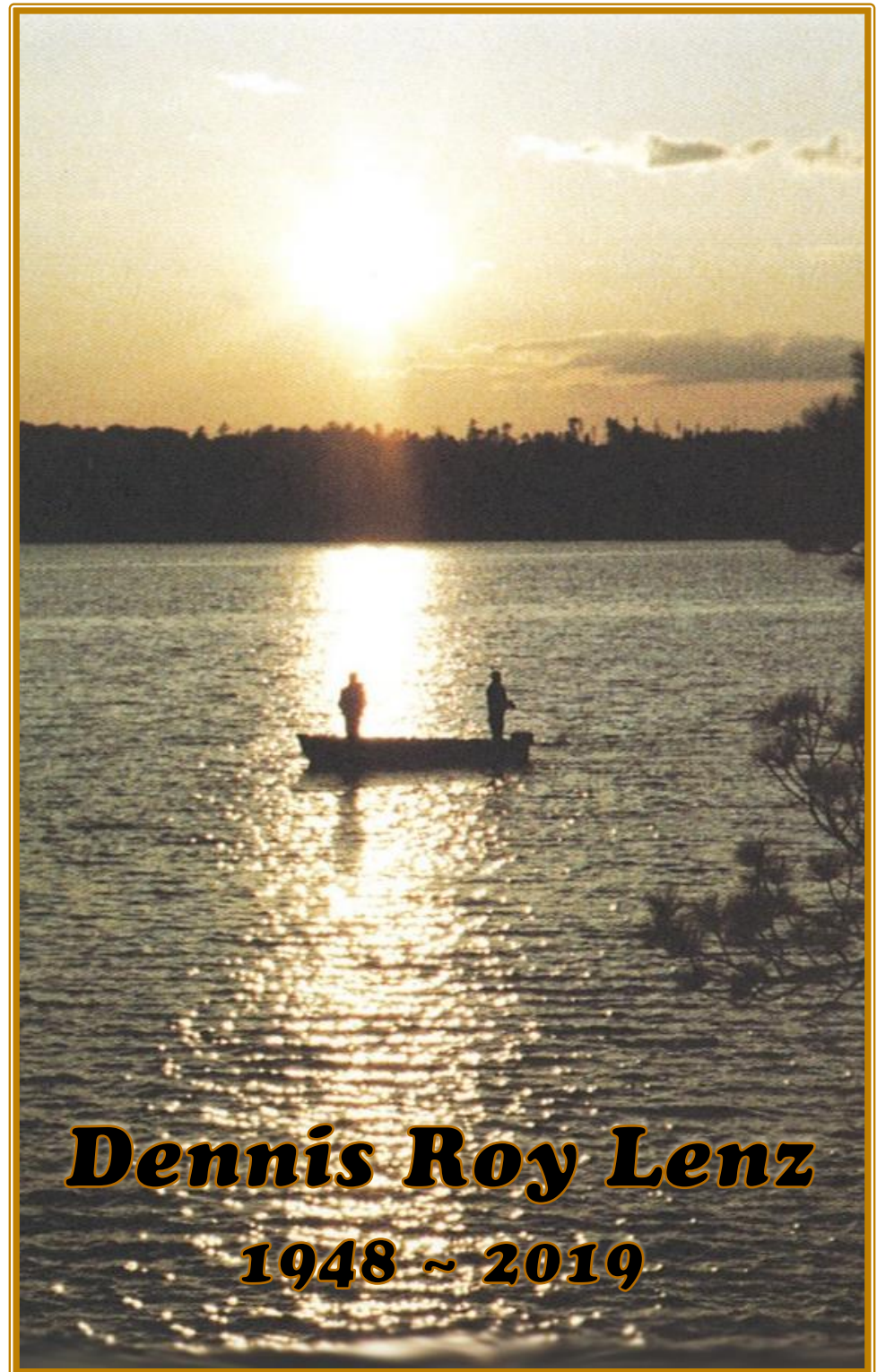
