Ivan made his Journey to the spirit world on February 7, 2016, at Sanford Hospital in Sioux Falls, SD, with his family by his side, at the age of 71.

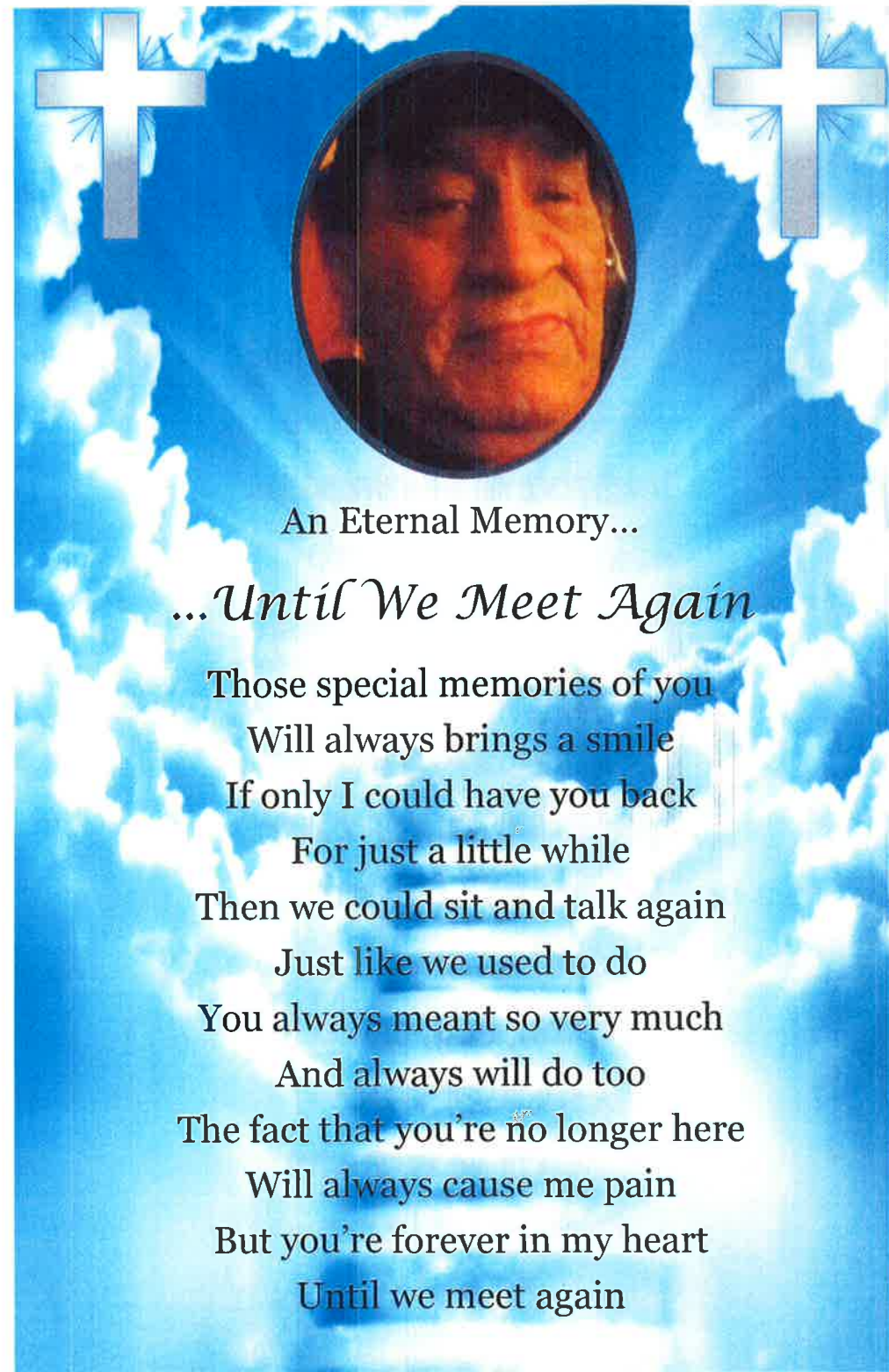
