

WALKING WITH GRANDMA

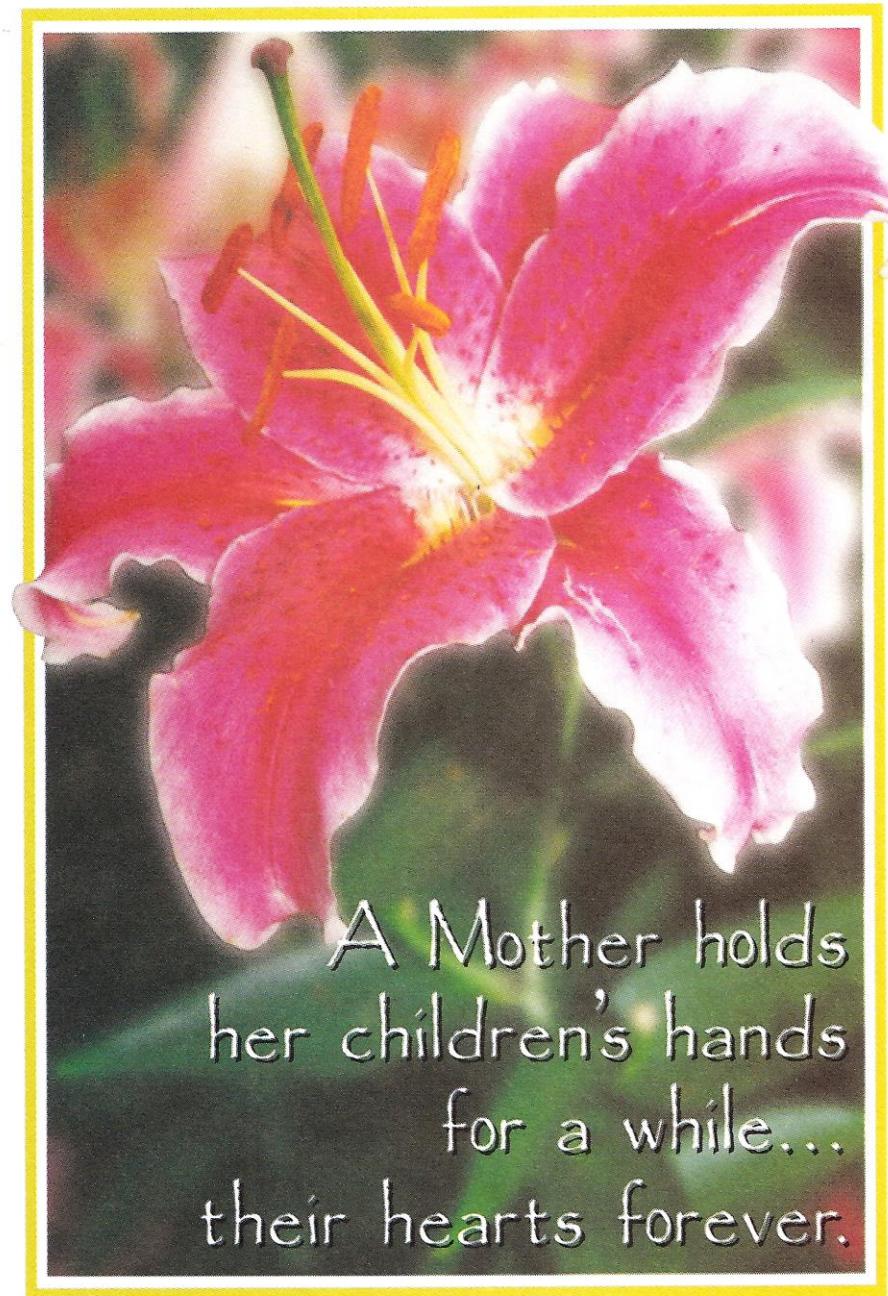
*I like to walk with Grandma
