'Til at last we're homeward bound.

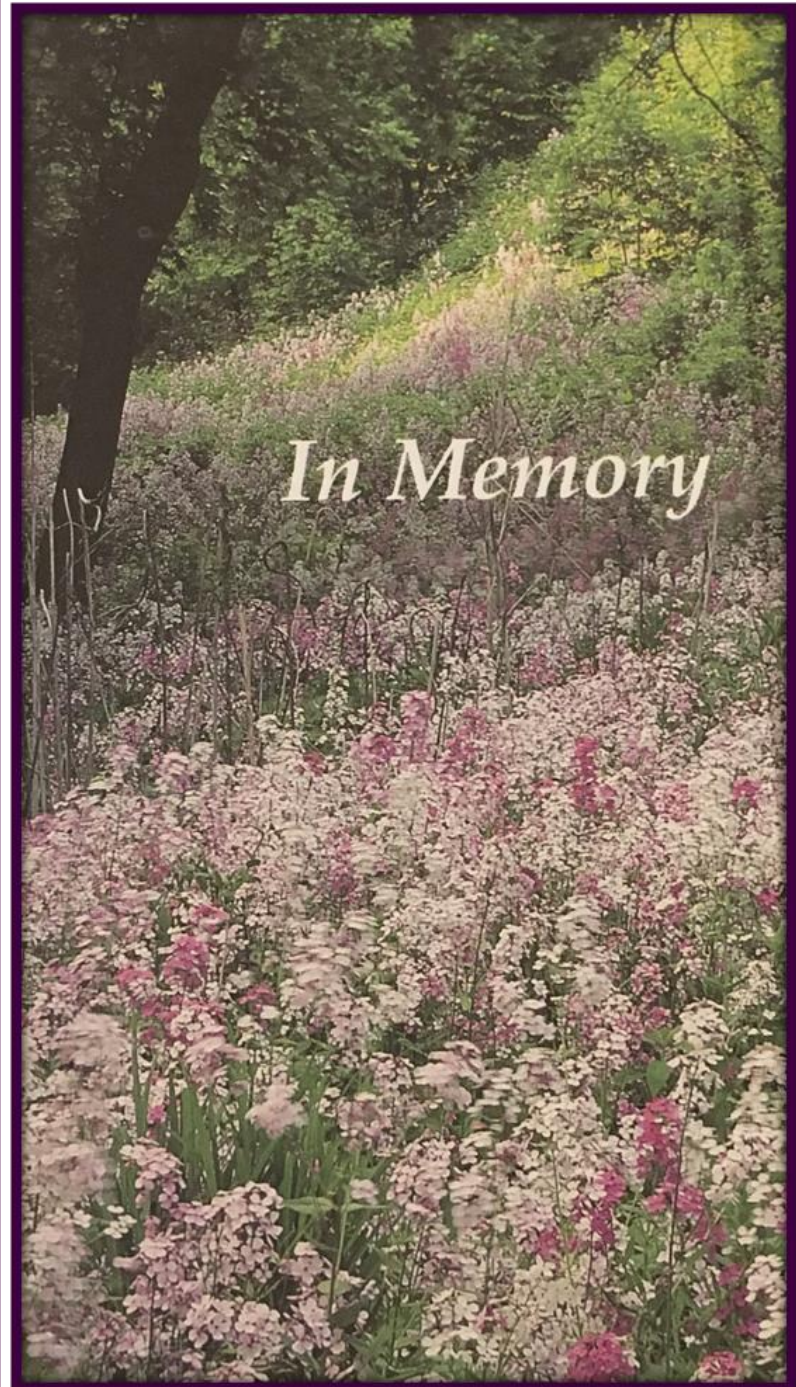
