And now I have my pick

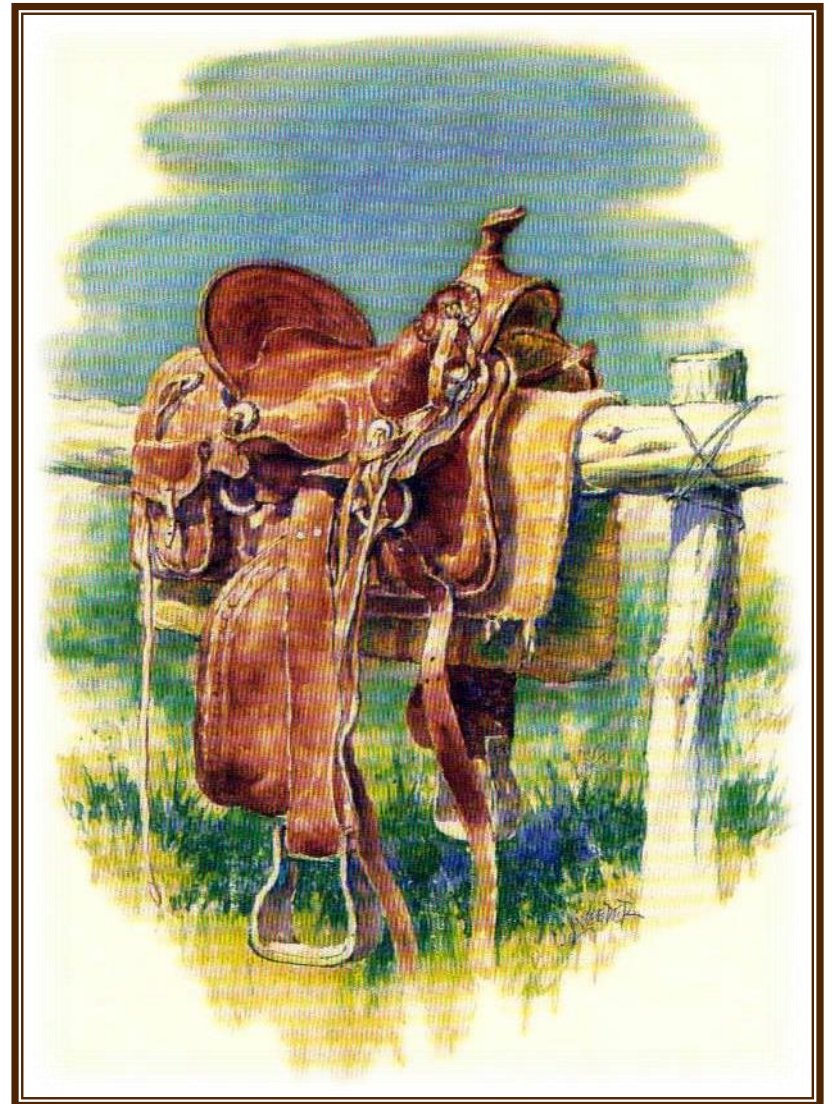
Lord, please forgive me of all my sins
