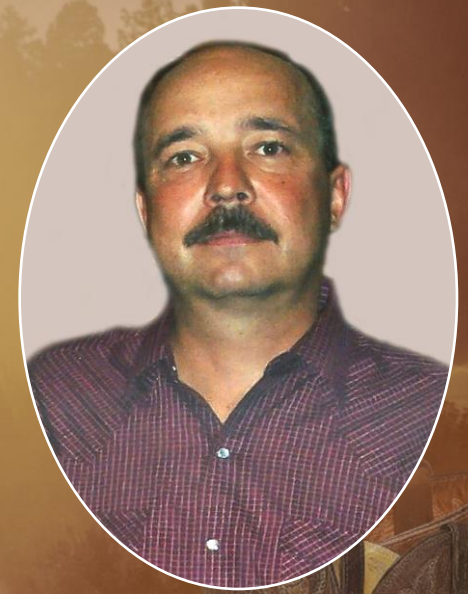


In Loving Memory

Clyde J. Fanning, Jr., 52, of Wolsey, passed away Tuesday, March 4, 2014 at the Huron Regional Medical Center.

Clyde was born July 4, 1961 in Miller, SD to Clyde and Betty (Weise) Fanning. He graduated from Miller High School. After high school, Clyde traveled the bull sale circuit, trimming cattle and preparing them for sales. He then moved to Red Lodge, Montana working for a mining operation laying leachpads.
