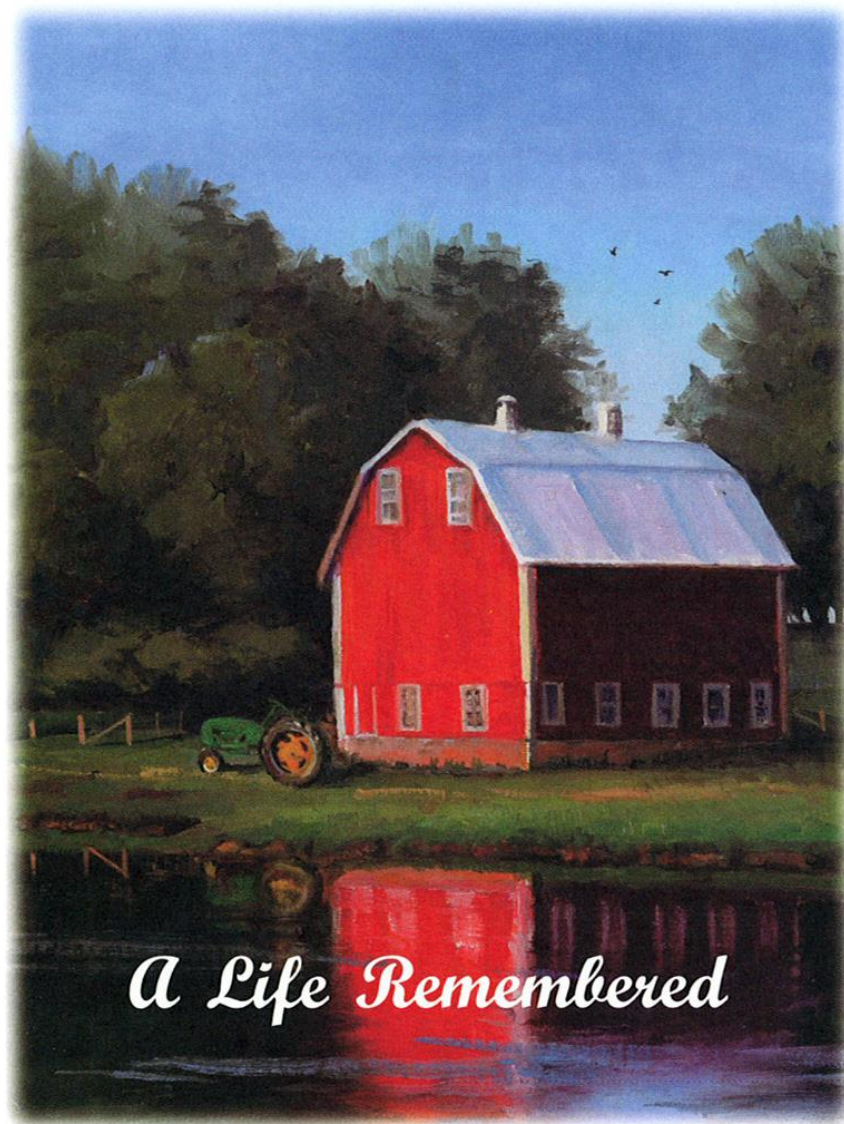
He was preceded in death by his parent; wife, Marie; and brothers: Ronald, Emerald, and Donald Reinhardt.

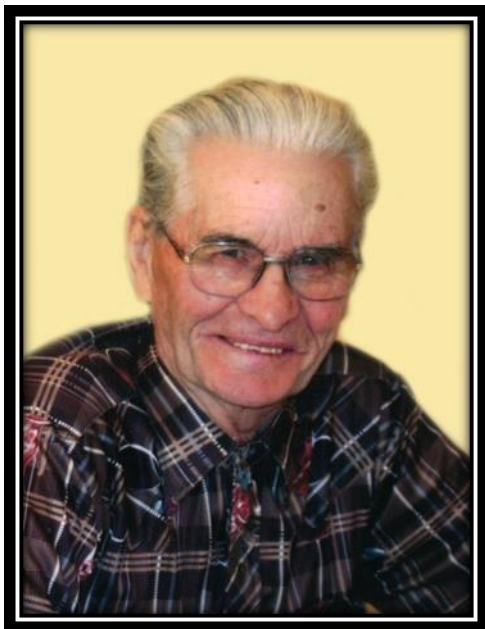
