We would not make her stay.

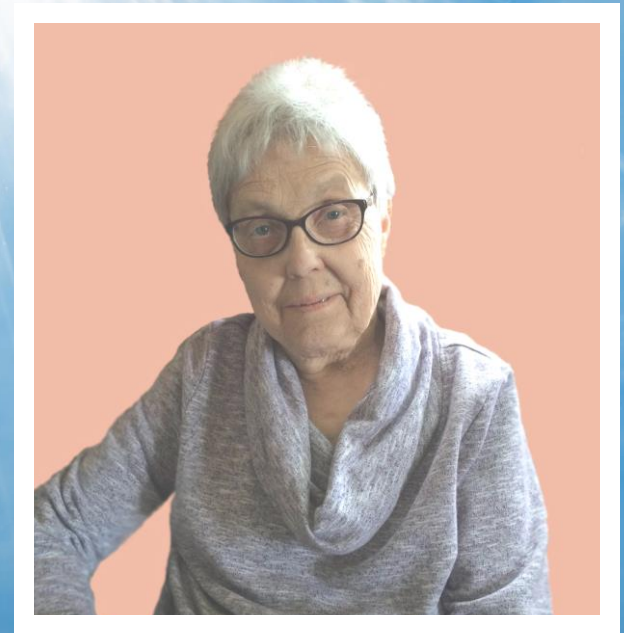
