

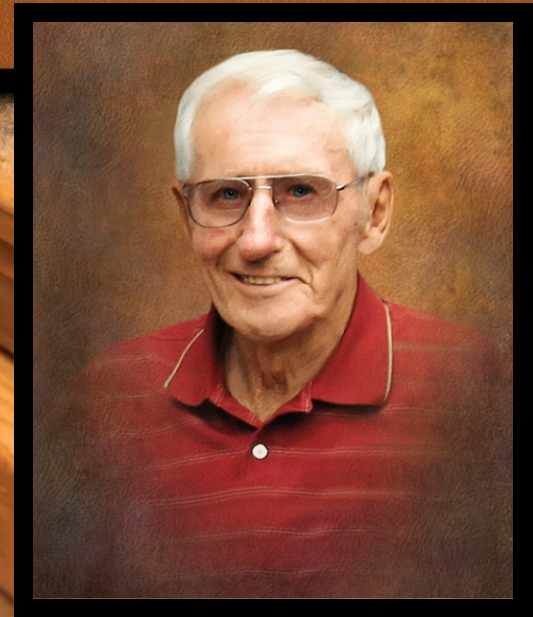
"WITH HIM"

Bud Puffer

Bayard "Bud" Puffer, 93, of Miller, passed away Tuesday, December 15, 2015 at the Good Samaritan Society in Miller.

Bud was born September 7, 1922 in Ree Heights, South Dakota to John and Minetta (Fritz) Puffer. He attended grade school in Como Township, high school in Miller for two years, and graduated from Ree Heights High School in 1941. On October 6, 1942, he married LaVonne Crawford at Cedar Catholic Church. They continued to live on the family ranch. He served on the School Board and Township Boards for twenty years.
