The day God called you home.*

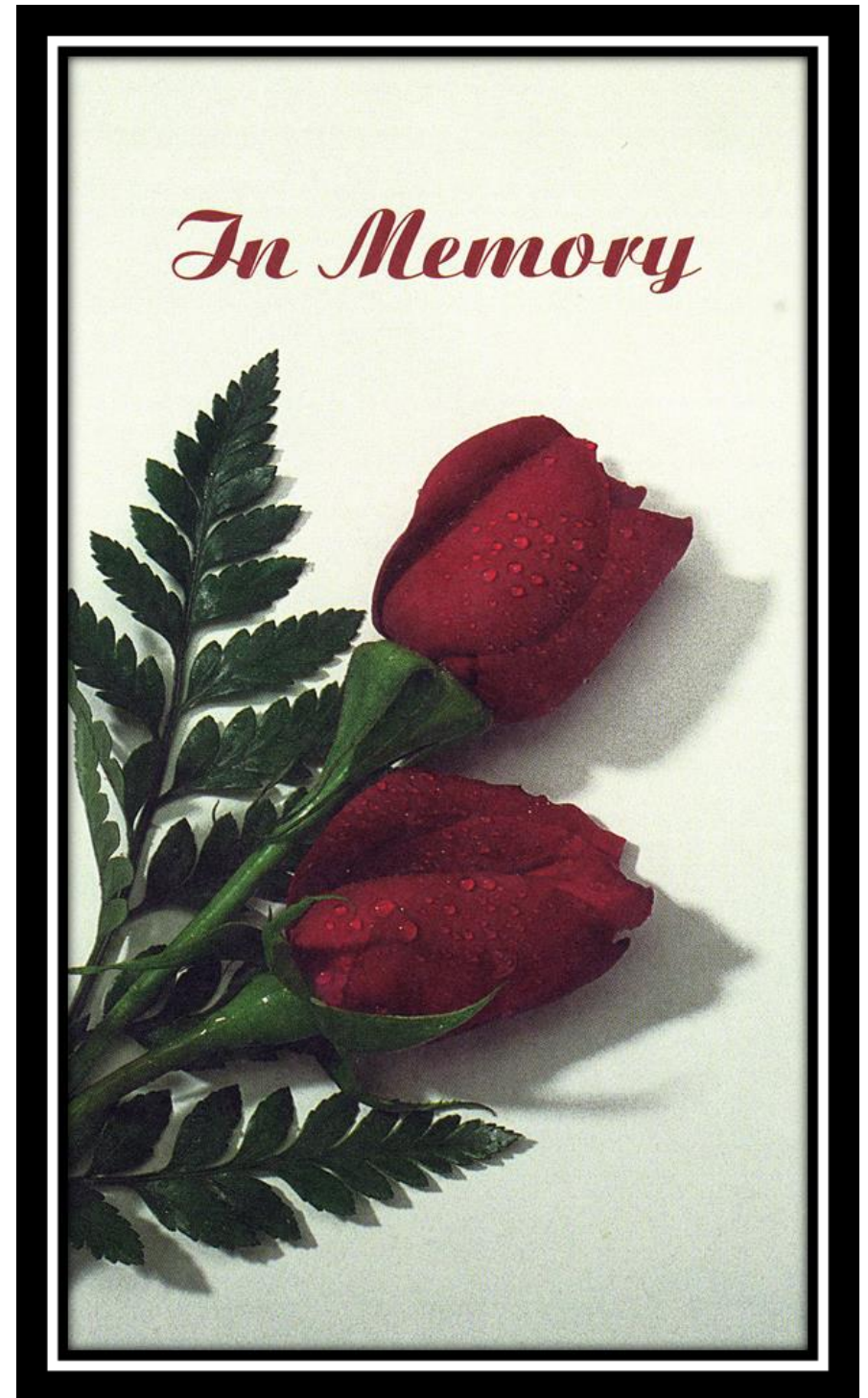
*God takes us one by one

Doris D. Jones, 99, of Miller, passed away Saturday, October 15, 2016 at the Avera Hand County Memorial Hospital in Miller.

Doris Dale was born January 13, 1917, on a farm south of Vayland, South Dakota, to Peter and Gertrude (Borkhuis) Olson. She went to elementary school in Vayland where she graduated 8th grade.
