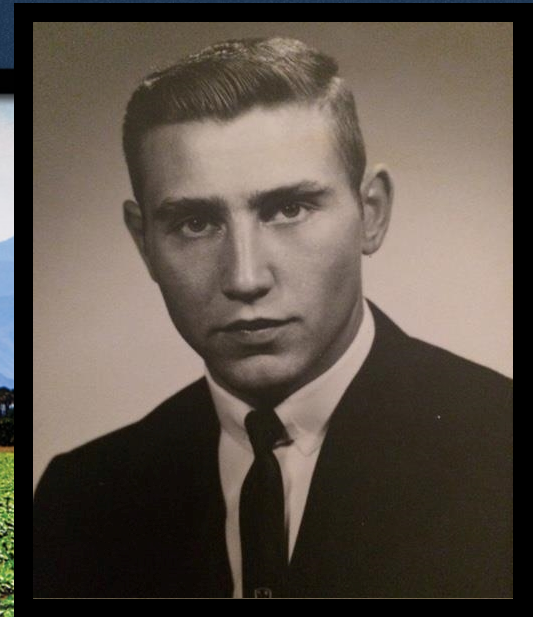


*God hath not promised
