

## *DON'T BE SAD*

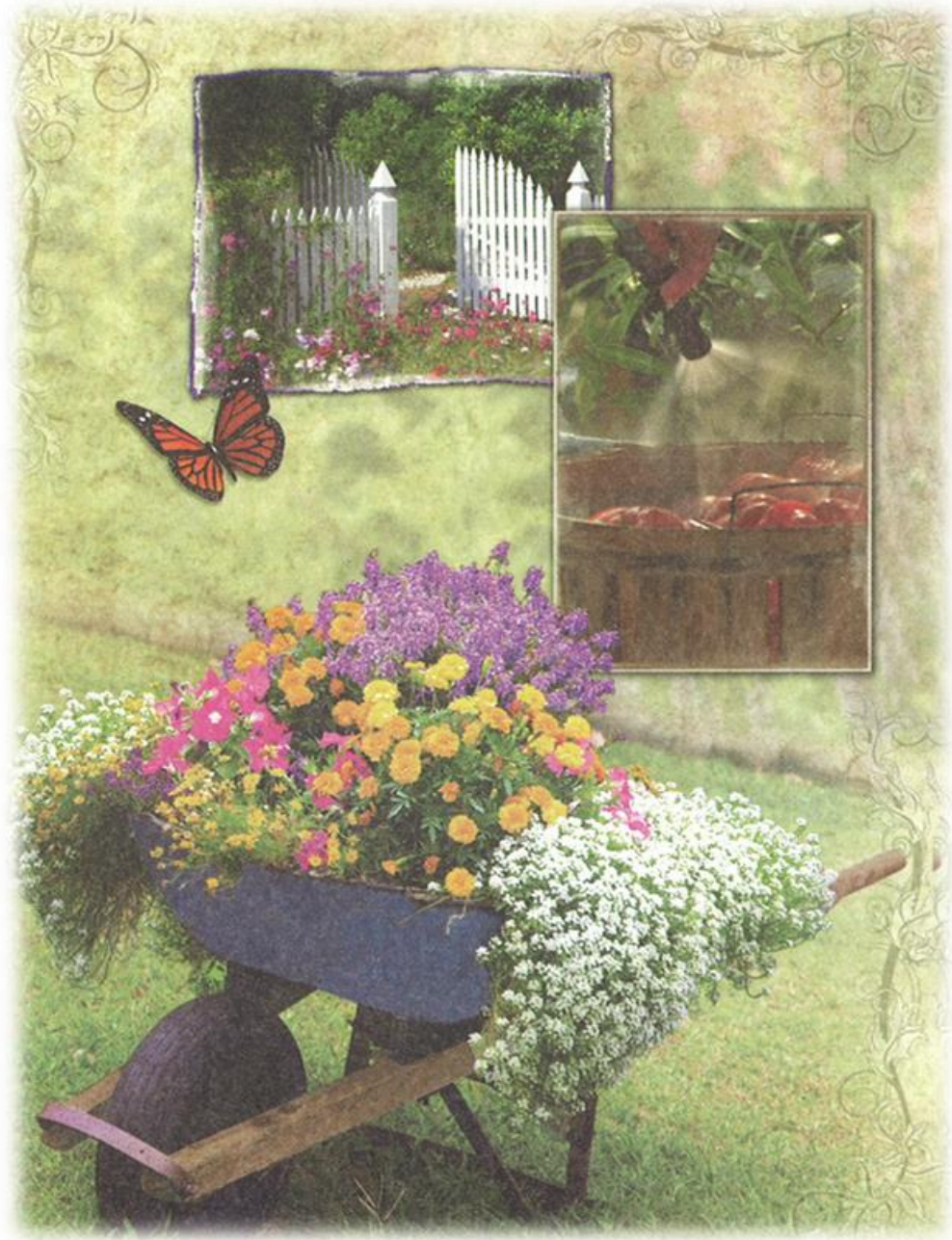
*Don't be sad and lonely,
