She always takes her time.*

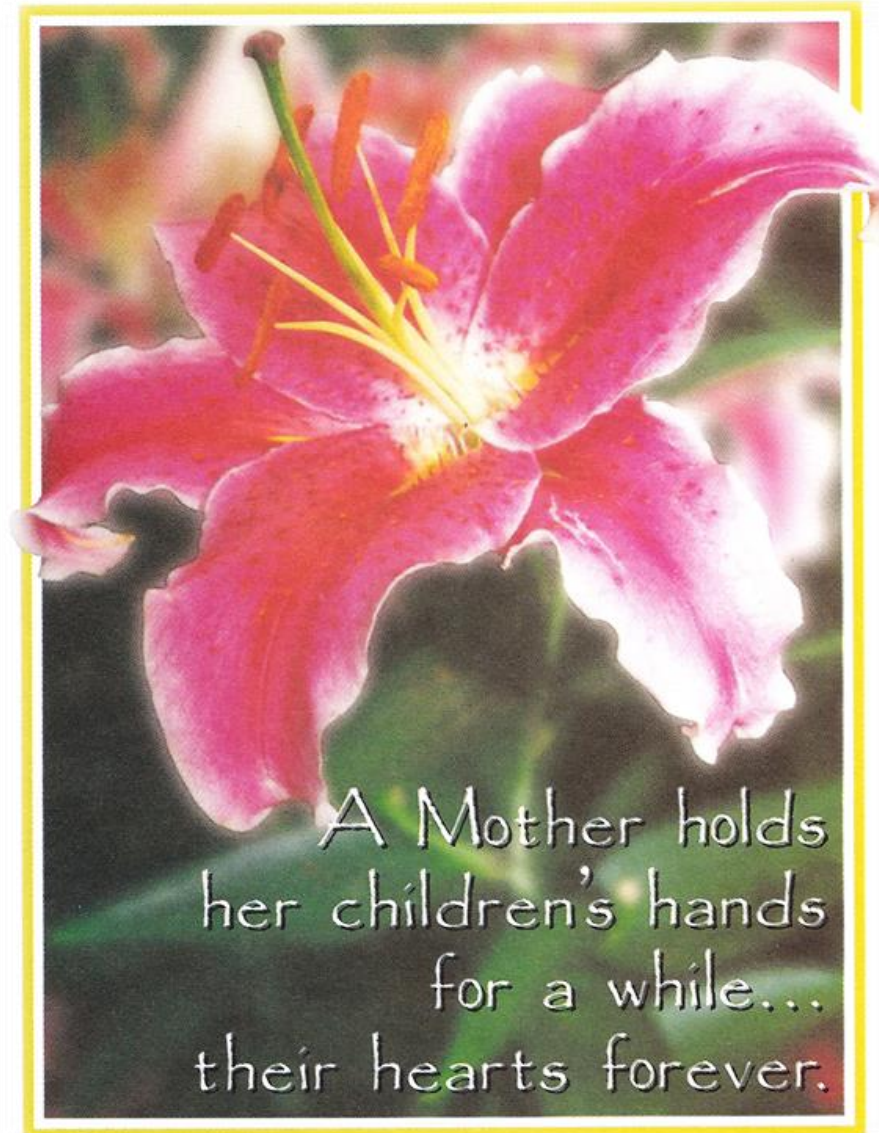
*I like to walk Grandma
