On December 20, 1952 she married Lewis "Pete" Meriweather in Sisseton, South Dakota. They moved throughout their early years. They resided in Sisseton, South Dakota; St. Paul, Minnesota; Wessington Springs, South Dakota; Scottsbluff, Nebraska.
