THROUGH THE NIGHT.



LARAMIE WAYNE URBAN WAS BORN MARCH 14, 1979, IN SIOUX FALLS, SD TO SHARON VERDUGT AND RON URBAN. THROUGH HIS ADOLESCENCE, HE LIVED IN FORT PIERRE, BUT THE MAJORITY OF HIS YOUTH WAS SPENT IN ST. LAWRENCE, SD. AS A CHILD, LARAMIE FOUND A DEEP LOVE OF ANIMALS THAT HE UNDOUBTEDLY GOT FROM HIS MOTHER. HE HELPED SHARON WITH HER HORSE AND DOG BUSINESS GROWING UP. LARAMIE ATTENDED MILLER JR./SR. HE ALWAYS HAD HIS PIT BULL WITH HIM, WHO HE WOULD CONSIDER HIS TRUEST FRIEND. LARAMIE HAD A VERY KIND SOUL, AND ALTHOUGH MISUNDERSTOOD BY SOME, HE WANTED TO HELP PEOPLE WHERE HE COULD.
