


The LORD is my *Shepherd;*

Celebrating THE Life OF **Scottie Gibson**

June 23, 1948 - September 22, 2022



Scottie Gibson, 74, of St. Lawrence, passed away Thursday, September 22, 2022, at the Community Memorial Hospital Avera in Redfield, SD.

Scottie LeRoy Gibson was born June 23, 1948 to Walter and Lavina (Prohaska) Gibson in Hand County.
