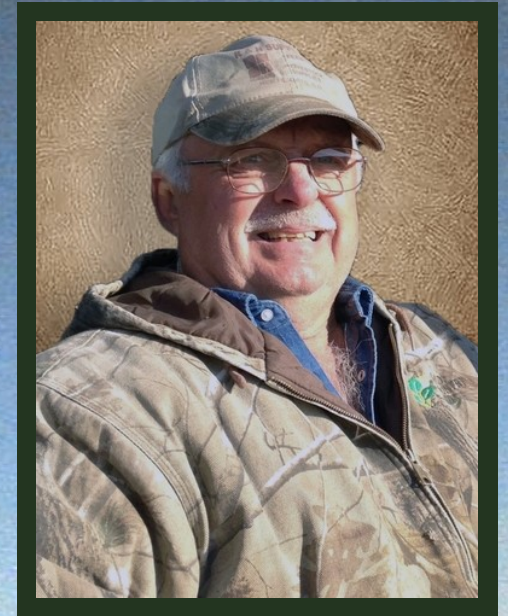

Michael (Mike) Morris Cook of Ree Heights, South Dakota passed away at Avera McKennan Hospital on May 2, 2023, at the age of 74 with his family at his side.
