Judith Mae Jenner, 84, formerly of Miller, was called home by the Lord on Wednesday, June 3, 2026, after a brief period of hospice care in Brighton, CO.

Judy was born on November 6, 1941, to Carl and Mae Fischer in Herried, SD, the fourth of five children. After graduating from Miller High School in 1960, she started her career at First National Bank (First State Bank – Miller / Quoin Bank), where she gave 36 years of joyful service as a clerk and loan officer.
